PAC Principal Notes April 22, 2021

Thank you for all of your hard work organizing the Growing Smiles and the Spirit Wear fundraisers! Thank you for supporting the Health and Safety guidelines and processes at our school. This goes a long way toward keeping our school community safe and Covid free.

1. 2021/22 Projections and Staffing

- **a.** Projections for next year are for 263 students with 12 divisions. We currently have 35 Kindergarten students registered.
- b. The district sent out a survey today to figure out interest in blended learning for next year. The program is changing K-7 will be virtual M/T/Th/F and in person on Wednesday. Depending on the results we may, or may not, have blended learning in our school next year as it could be a regional location.

2. Ready, Set, Learn

- a. The RSL event is virtual this year a link will be sent out to all participants who register to access it when convenient a book and small materials to support the program will be sent home through the mail or a sibling.
- b. So far, we only have 1 registrant please encourage any neighbors or friends with 3- and 4-year-old children (not entering K in the Fall) to access the registration link on our website.

3. **Playground -** the quote will include the ground preparation and the equipment.

- a. Habitat provided with 2 drawings showing two different accessible playgrounds; both include an incline from the paved pathway one is \$155 000, and the other is \$165 000. One includes the Sway Fun, which is a pilot item currently being piloted in the district. By the time we have funding it should be approved for use. The rubberized ground is not included in the quote but may not be necessary as the ground drainage is much improved from our original playground installation and the playground ramp goes from the paved sidewalk. We could get a quote for the rubberized ground on top of the playground costs.
- b. Swing Time met with representative and drawings and quotes should be sent soon. She will provide the quote in a way that could be divided into phase one/phase two if needed. She will also get us a rubberized ground quote but also said that the new way the woodchip ground is done will be accessible as well and much better than the old ground we have on the other playground. Plus the



playground will begin at ground level from the pathway. She will also include a quote with installation and with volunteers for the installation with supervision.

- c. Once we have quotes and drawings from both companies I will share with staff and get their thoughts, as well as the PAC;s thoughts and choose a company.
- d. Both companies have fundraising packages, ideas, support.
- e. Grant applications can start once the final company, drawing and quote are chosen.
- 4. **Drainage Issue** the drain near the playground was repaired and the puddle issue should be gone or much better –we will see when it rains again!
